Notes from the Pastor

Wheelchair Lifts. The wheelchair lifts have been installed for the school and the church basement. A concrete sidewalk still needs to be poured for access to the church basement wheelchair lift.

Auction Updates. The auction is now three weeks away. Our auction website is being finalized, yet you can still go and browse through the items that we have to be auctioned off. As you know, our auction is divided into three auctions: (1) the traditional in-person Silent auction, (2) the traditional in-person Live (Oral) auction, and (3) an Online auction.

Donated items have been divided and placed into the three auctions. You can view them via the menu options on the website. [Note that the numbering and sequencing of items will change once we have everything entered and begin to print the books.]

Items in the Silent and Online auctions are similar. If we had two similar or identical items donated, one was placed in the Silent auction and one in the Online auction. We tried to make both auctions a good bidding experience. Note: all baked food items were placed into the Silent auction, so that they can be picked up at the night of the auction.

You can, of course, participate in all three auctions, if you attend in person. If you are not attending in person, you can bid on the Online auction items and the Live auction items. To bid on Live auction items, click on the "Live Auction" link when the Live auction starts (Sept. 17th at 7:30pm). You will be taken to an online live platform managed by Farmland Auction/Pfeifer Brothers.

For Online bidders, you can pre-bid on Silent auction items, but will have to be present to continue bidding. Note that your pre-bid amount may be the winning bid (i.e., no one bids any higher). You will be contacted via email if you are the winner when the Silent Auction closes and the winning bids are entered into the system.

Online bidding and Pre-bidding begin Tuesday, September 13 at 12:00am. Pre-bidding ends Thursday, September 15 at 11:00pm. Online bidding ends Saturday, September 17 at 12:00pm (Noon).

We still have plenty of in-person tickets available. After August 31, ticket prices will increase, so purchase your tickets soon. Come enjoy the evening with us—the Auction Committee has a lot of fun planned!

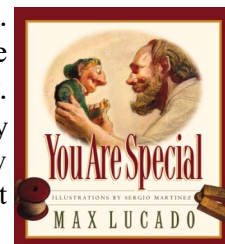
